Phase out by 2026 per Illinois TRM 8.0

2020 Proposed	\$ 20,100,000 + PHES

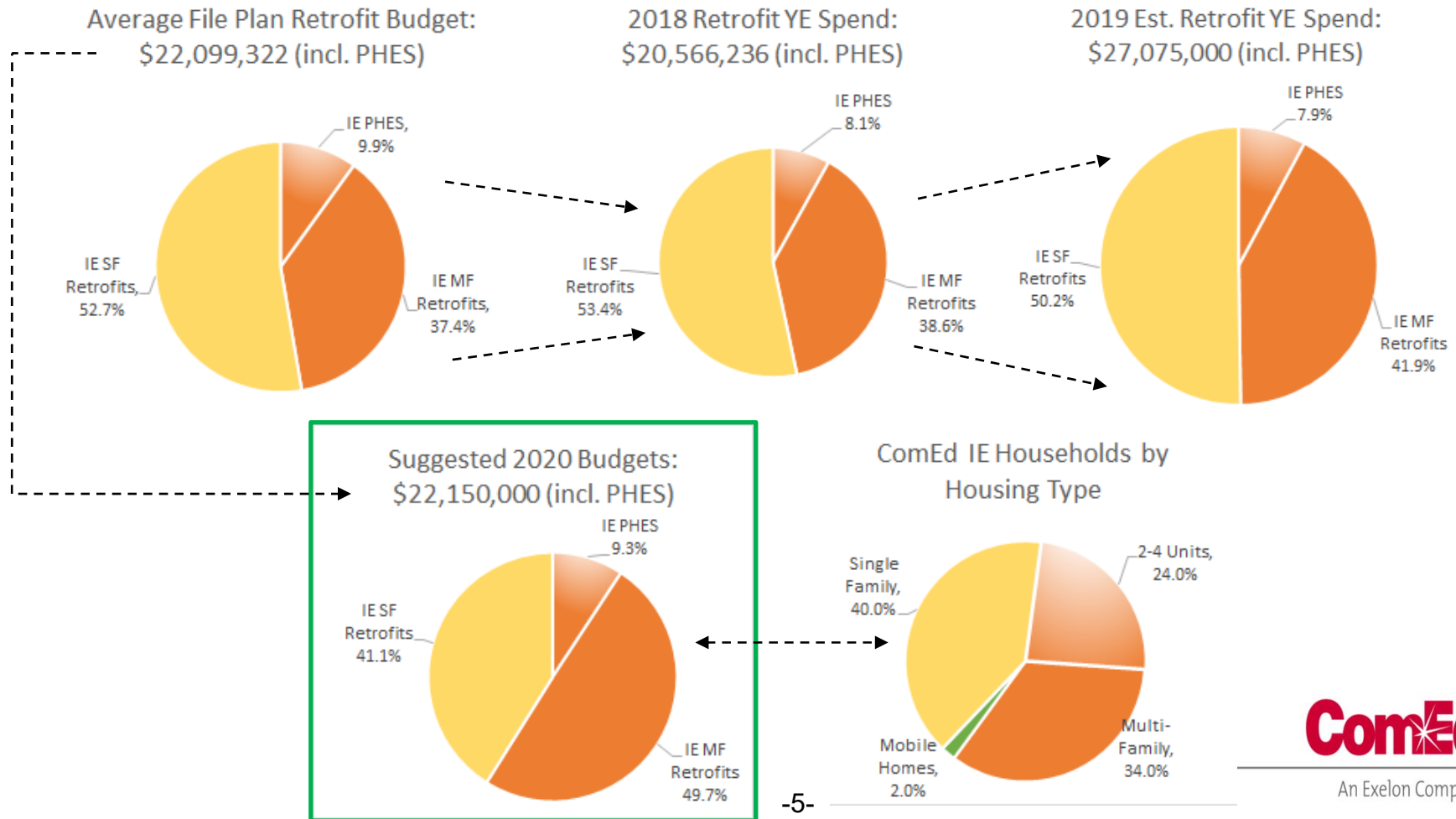
PHES = Public Housing Energy Savings (aka Public Housing Retrofits)

✓ Home savings calculator

A real-time project cost/savings calculator developed to assess existing conditions, potential health and safety costs, and potential savings opportunities during an initial home energy assessment visit.

Goal: Reduce the number of projects deemed ineligible after the assessment

Affordable Housing New Construction

- ✓ Updated *ComEd Multi-Family Standard*
 - Separate Renovation Compliance Path

Addressing a service gap identified between the Affordable Housing New Construction and Multi-Family Retrofits

Alternative compliance paths for these measures:

- Window replacement alternative (historic buildings)
- Reduced Infiltration/ Air Sealing
- Reduced Thermal Bridging
- High-Performance HVAC Equipment
- Efficient Ventilation

Affordable Housing New Construction

- ✓ Updated *ComEd Multi-Family Standard*
 - Separate Renovation Compliance Path

Addressing a service gap identified between the Affordable Housing New Construction and Multi-Family Retrofits

Remaining requirements must be met for all buildings:

- High-Performance Fans
- Advanced HVAC Controls
- High-Performance Lighting (Interior and Exterior)
- Interior Lighting Controls
- High-Performance Water Heating Equipment
- Hot Water Conservation
- ENERGY STAR® Appliances
